

Business Impact Estimate

Proposed ordinance's title/reference:
Ordinance 31-26

An Ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Cape Coral, Florida, amending Ordinance 9-26, which provided for a referendum to consider the adoption of amendments to Section 4.06, "Mayor; Mayor Pro Tem," of the City of Cape Coral, Florida, Charter concerning the election of a Council member to serve as Mayor Pro Tem, by amending the referendum ballot title; providing for publication of a notice of the referendum election; providing for severability and an effective date.

Proposal amends the Cape Coral City Charter to clarify that the election of the Mayor Pro Tem shall be by the majority vote of the City Council to be held at the first regular council meeting following each General Election.
