



What is the Southwest Florida Fine Craft Expo?

The 25th annual Southwest Florida Fine Craft Expo is a fundraiser brought to you by the Southwest Florida Fine Craft Guild, a non-profit artist collective, in partnership with Cape Coral Art Center. This art-filled weekend includes make-and-take workshops, an artwork raffle fundraiser, and a reception for the annual Expressions exhibition.

All proceeds from the raffle go towards supporting young artists through scholarships, providing local children with free camp registration for Creativity Camp at the Cape Coral Art Center. There, a STEAM-based curriculum is offered to children ages 7-12, with fun weekly themes. Children create hands-on art, including paintings, mixed media projects, and air-dry clay.

What is the South West Florida Fine Craft Guild?

The Southwest Florida Fine Craft Guild is a vibrant collective of artisans, explorers, and creators dedicated to the art of fine crafting. Both seasoned artisans and curious new comers are invited to dive into the rich world of handmade artistry. With a passion for craftsmanship that echoes the region's lush natural beauty, the guild hosts workshops, exhibits, and events that showcase an array of artistic disciplines—from pottery and glasswork to textiles and woodcraft. Since 1971, the guild has fostered connections and inspired creativity, encouraging artisans to push their boundaries and explore new territories in their craft.

What is Cape Coral Art Center?

The Cape Coral Art Center has been an artist community resource in Southwest Florida since 1977. Located in Rubicond Park on Coronado Parkway in Southeast Cape, the Art Center is a recreation center for the City of Cape Coral which offers year-round classes and workshops for residents and guests of all ages and skill levels in fine arts and fine crafts. No memberships are required for participation. Beyond classes, Cape Coral Art Center showcases captivating exhibitions that bring local and regional artists' work into the spotlight.
