FUN FACTS ABOUT *Jaycee Park*

1. Officially opens to the public on Thursday, April 30
2. Ribbon-cutting ceremony set for Friday, May 8, at 10 a.m.
3. More than 425 trees have been planted, nearly doubling the number of trees originally at the park
4. Low-lying grassy areas double as stormwater features to help manage rainwater naturally
5. Offers stunning sunrise views over the Caloosahatchee River
6. Parking expanded from 77 to 128 spaces for easier access
7. Designed for all abilities, including an inclusive playground and a special needs adult changing table
8. Home to the City's first public splash pad, spanning 5,000 square feet
9. Nearly 1.5 miles of shaded walking paths wind through the park
10. Entrance sign thoughtfully designed to preserve the unique waterfront view
