## City of Cape Coral Traffic Engineering Department - Criteria for approving a sign to warn vehicular drivers of the presence of a blind, deaf or other sensory impaired child:

- 1. A formal written request to the City's Traffic Engineering Department from the parent or legal guardian of the child including:
  - a. A statement from the child's doctor identifying the child's diagnosed sensory impairment/limitation.
  - b. Child's date of birth.
- 2. Signs provided for children fourteen years of age or younger:
  - a. Requested extensions approved by City's Traffic Engineering Department on a case by case basis.
  - b. Responsibility of the parent or legal guardian to notify the City's Traffic Engineering Department when the child reaches the age of fifteen.
- 3. Signs installed on the street of the primary residence of the child:
  - a. Responsibility of the parent or legal guardian to notify the City's Traffic Engineering Department when the child /family relocates from the residence.
  - Requests may be approved for signs on additional streets if the child receives daily care in a second residence and documentation is provided to the City's Traffic Engineering Department.
- 4. The placement of the sign must follow good signing practices, without compromising the effectiveness of other signs or traffic control devices in the area.
