



**In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the January 21, 2026, Cape Coral City Council meeting.**

**Council Awards Contract for New Sidewalks**

Council approved Resolution 11-26, awarding a contract to Newson Construction and Consulting, LLC, for the construction of a five-foot-wide sidewalk along the west side of Southwest Santa Barbara Place from Nicholas Parkway to Southwest 20th Street, continuing on the north side of Southwest 20th Street.

**Council Approves Grant Funding for Firefighter Safety**

Council approved Resolution 21-26 accepting \$25,296 in grant funding from the Florida Department of Financial Services to buy equipment, supplies, and training to reduce firefighters' exposure to hazardous, cancer-causing chemicals, with the City providing a \$14,704 match.

**Council Accepts Grant Funding for the Northeast Reservoir Project**

Council approved Resolution 22-26, accepting \$6,000,000 in grant funding from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection to assist in funding the construction of a 3.2 mile 36-inch pipeline on US-41 and a new pump station at the City's Northeast Reservoir in support of the Cape Coral Northeast Reservoir Project.

**Council Approves Development Agreement for Seven Island Development**

Council approved Ordinance 60-25, approving a Development Agreement with Gulf Gateway Resort & Marina LLC, establishing terms and conditions for the Seven Islands development.
