



In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the January 7, 2026, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

Council Awards Contracts for North RO Plant Expansion

Council approved Resolution 2-26 and Resolution 3-26, in support of Phase I of the North Reverse Osmosis Water Treatment Plant Expansion Project, awarding a bid to Douglas N. Higgins, Inc., for the construction of above-ground well facilities, and a bid to Accurate Drilling Systems, Inc., for the installation and testing of a raw water main pipeline.

Council Awards Contract for New Sidewalks

Council approved Resolution 10-26, awarding contract to H.W. Lochner, Inc. for construction, engineering, and inspection services for the installation of sidewalks on both sides of Andalusia Boulevard and the West side of Skyline Boulevard.

Council Authorizes Funds for Crime Prevention Programs

Council approved Resolution 13-26, approving the use of \$61,314.22 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund for crime prevention programs, including the City of Cape Coral Police Department Community Services Bureau, Investigative Services Bureau Forensic Science Unit, and the Special Operations Bureau Dive Team.

Council Approves Grant Funding for Drug Influence Evaluation

Council approved Resolution 14-26, accepting grant funding from the Florida Department of Transportation in an amount not to exceed \$6,000 for the Drug Recognition Expert Call-out Program.

Council Approves Measures for Victim Services

Council Approved Resolution 15-26, approving an agreement with and accepting grant funding from the Florida Department of Legal Affairs, Office of the Attorney General, for the Victim of Crimes Services Program.
