



In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the February 18, 2026, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

Council Approves Engineering Services Proposal for New Traffic Signal

Council approved Resolution 26-26, approving a staffing and cost proposal with Kisinger Campo and Associates, Corp., to provide professional engineering services for a new traffic signal at the intersection of Tropicana Parkway and Chiquita Boulevard.

Council Awards Contract for Roundabout Study

Council approved Resolution 36-26, approving a contract with Johnson Engineering, LLC, for the Cape Coral Roundabout Study. This study supports the City's Local Agency Program agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation.

Council Awards Contract for Water Quality Restoration Plan

Council approved Resolution 38-26, awarding a contract with Geosyntec Consultants, Inc. to provide consulting services to develop the North Cape Coral Drainage Basin Alternative Restoration Plan. The City was awarded grant funding under the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery to perform this plan, which aims to develop a long-term comprehensive alternative restoration plan for the Charlotte Harbor Estuary Watershed.
