



In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the February 4, 2026, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

Council Accepts Marine Equipment Donation from Lee County Sheriff's Office

Council approved Resolution 40-26, accepting the donation of a 2007 24' Everglades boat, a 2007 first load trailer, and a 2023 350HP Mercury Verado XXL engine from the Lee County Sheriff's Office for use by the Cape Coral Police Department, Special Operations Bureau, Marine Enforcement Unit.

Council Approves Additional Grant Funding for Pedestrian, Bike & Vehicle Safety

Council approved Resolution 32-26, accepting additional grant funding from the Florida Department of Transportation for on-street overtime operations specific to pedestrian, bicycle safety, and driving behaviors, in the amount of \$15,000, for a total grant amount of \$35,102.43.

Council Awards Contract to Support North Reverse Osmosis Water Treatment Plant Expansion Project

Council approved Resolution 29-26, awarding a bid to Wells & Water Systems, Inc. for the installation and testing of ten water supply wells for Phase 2 of the North Reverse Osmosis Water Treatment Plant Expansion Project.
