



In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the April 15, 2026, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

Community Recognition Award: BMX 2026 Worlds Team USA

City Council and the City Manager recognize the exemplary achievements of Cape Coral residents. During the Sunshine State National Race held at Strausser BMX Sports Complex, fourteen riders from Cape Coral earned a spot on Team USA to compete in the 2026 World Championship in Brisbane, Australia.

Council Approves Roof Replacement for Lake Kennedy Senior Center

Council approved Resolution 84-26, approving a contract with Target Roofing for the Roof Replacement and Carport Repair at Lake Kennedy Senior Center. The current architectural shingle roof was last replaced in 2003. Since that time, Cape Coral has been significantly impacted by three major hurricanes, causing devastating damage to the current roofing system.

Council Approves Upgrade of Police Mobile Command Center

Council approved Resolution 86-26, approving the purchase of a new Mobile Command Center for the Cape Coral Police Department, using grant funds in the amount of \$176,250, and a cash match of \$82,150 from Special Revenue Funds through the Department of Justice Asset Forfeiture/Equitable Sharing Program. The current Mobile Command Vehicle has surpassed its useful life, with rising maintenance needs, reduced reliability, and outdated technology. A new vehicle will provide a secure, centralized command center to improve communication, coordination, and efficiency during major incidents, strengthening overall public safety.

Council Approves Renovations to Pelican Baseball Complex

Council approved Resolution 88-26, approving renovations to Pelican Baseball Complex as part of Project Sparkle, which aims to improve venues for local programs and regional competitive events. Renovations include site, field, concession, and restroom improvements intended to enhance safety, accessibility, and the overall condition of the facility.
