



In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the May 20, 2026, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

Council Awards Business Infrastructure Grant to Liberty Health Park

Council approved Resolution 109-26, approving an agreement with Liberty Health Park, awarding a Business Infrastructure Grant in an amount not to exceed \$197,636 for the construction of a commercial banking facility. This supports the City's goals of attracting and expanding targeted business and financial services, stimulating private investment, creating higher-wage employment opportunities, and diversifying the City's commercial tax base by strengthening its business and financial services sector.

Council Approves Hurricane Damage Repairs for City Hall

Council approved Resolution 127-26, awarding a contract to Johnson-Laux Construction for repairs to City Hall due to Hurricane Milton storm damage. Eighty-eight perimeter windows will be replaced as part of the repair project, bringing City Hall and Council Chambers back to their pre-disaster function.

Council Awards Contracts for Median Beautification Projects

Council approved Resolutions 128-26 and 129-26, awarding contracts to P&T Lawn & Tractor Service for median beautification projects on Surfside Boulevard between Veterans Parkway and Trafalgar Parkway, as well as Trafalgar Parkway to SW 20th Avenue, and Shelby Parkway between SW 26th Terrace and Del Prado Boulevard South. Improvements include the installation of trees/palms, irrigation, and St. Augustine sod.

Council Approved Hector Cafferata Sidewalk, Turn Lane Project

Council Approved Resolution 124-26, awarding a contract to Andrew Site Work, LLC, for design services of new sidewalks and turn lanes on Embers Parkway. These improvements are needed due to the relocation of Hector A. Cafferata Elementary School to its new site northeast of the intersection of Embers Parkway and El Dorado Boulevard.
