



In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the July 15, 2026, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

Council Accepts Additional Grant Funding for Weir Improvement

Council approves Resolution 153-26, accepting an additional \$560,367 in grant funding for the Weir 7 Improvement Project. This increases the total grant funding to \$1.2M, reducing the City's contribution to just under \$300,000. The Weir 7 Improvement Project includes installing new liner pipes and seawall bulkheads, adding manatee protection grates, and installing remotely operated adjustable gates to improve flood control during storm events.

Council Accepts Funding for Repairs of Surfside, Sands Bridges

Council approves Resolutions 161-26 and 162-26, accepting funding from the Florida Department of Transportation for construction engineering and inspection services for the Surfside Boulevard Bridge over the Maxine Canal (\$353,516) and the Sands Boulevard Bridge over the Eternity Canal (\$1.4M). These projects address damage from Hurricane Ian and aim to restore the long-term functionality of the bridges.

Council Accepts \$6.5M in Grant Funding for North 1 East UEP

Council Approved Resolution 172-26, accepting \$6.5M in grant funding for the North 1 UEP East Reclaimed Water Extension project. The North 1 Utilities Extension Project (UEP) includes installation of water, wastewater, and irrigation mains with associated appurtenances to transition residents from private wells and septic systems to the City's municipal utility services.
