



In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the September 16, 2026, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

Cape Coral acknowledges National Prisoners of War/Missing in Action Recognition Day. City Council held a moment of silence in honor of this day on Friday, September 18, 2026.

City Staff Award: Achievement of Excellence from the National Procurement Institute

City Council and the City Manager recognize the exemplary achievements of Cape Coral's Procurement Division. This recognition honors the City's dedication to procurement excellence and reflects its commitment to innovation, professionalism, and leadership.

Council Approves Rehabilitation of Master Pump Station 200

Council approved Resolution 238-26, authorizing the City to enter into a contract with Pape-Dawson Consulting Engineers, LLC, for the rehabilitation of Master Pump Station 200, located at 3601 Del Prado Boulevard. Rehabilitation is needed due to the station's age, condition, and critical role in the City's utility system. The contract includes permitting, design, and professional engineering services.

Council Approves Rescue Equipment and Communication System

Council approved Resolution 250-26, authorizing the purchase of specialized technical-rescue equipment and communication equipment for the Cape Coral Fire Department. The equipment will support firefighters during complex rescue operations.

Council Approves Construction for North Fleet Maintenance Facility

Council approved Resolution 259-26, establishing the construction price for the North Cape Government Complex Fleet Maintenance Facility, located at 1200 Kismet Parkway West. The project includes site development and infrastructure improvements to support the City's Fleet Maintenance operations. Charles Perry Partners, Inc., will serve as the contractor for the project.
