



In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the September 2, 2026, Cape Coral City Council meeting.

Council Approves North Reverse Osmosis Perimeter Wall

Council approved Resolution 227-26, allowing for the construction of a new eight-foot perimeter wall around the City's North Reverse Osmosis Plant, located at 1200 Kismet Parkway. The current chain link fence surrounding the property was installed in 2008. Due to its age and weathering, portions of the construction fence deteriorated and required removal.

Council Approves Emergency Roadway Repair

Council approved Resolution 228-26, authorizing an emergency purchase order to repair an 80-foot roadway depression in front of 1521 NW 16th Terrace. Immediate remediation is necessary to protect public safety, prevent further roadway failure, and limit potential damage to adjacent public and private property.

Council Accepts Victims of Crime Act Grant Funding

Council approved Resolution 241-26, accepting \$127,138 in grant funding from the State of Florida for the Victims of Crime Services Program. Funds will pay a percentage of personnel costs for two Victim Assistance Advocate positions at the Cape Coral Police Department.
