1.) Uniqueness of vendor's item/service. How is this vendor the only vendor uniquely qualified to provide the product or service:

Hudson Pump & Equipment Associates, Inc. is the only authorized distributor for Gorman Rupp wastewater equipment, parts, and repair. Gorman Rupp pumps and parts are used in municipal sewage lift stations and treatment plants, including units installed in the municipal collection system. Gorman Rupp portable diesel pumps are in use throughout the City of Cape Coral.

There are other brands of portable diesel pumps on the market, however, Cape Coral Utilities Collection and Distribution utilizes these Gorman Rupp portable pumps in its lift stations for emergencies/maintenance as well as in the plants for operational requirements. Maintaining uniformity in brand and pump type has proven cost effective long-term by reducing maintenance costs.

Describe the actions the department will take to overcome the present barriers to competition for any future acquisition of this product or service: We will continue to perform research on companies, components, processes, and equipment capable of meeting the needs of Public Works and the City of Cape Coral. SUBJECT: Sole Source Purchase Request – Gorman-Rupp Pump for Public Works Stormwater Division

BACKGROUND

The Public Works Stormwater Division requests approval to purchase a Single Source with Hudson Pump & Equipment Associates, Inc. This item is fully equipped and includes a tandem axle DOT-approved highway trailer with electric brakes, pintle hook, and NPT (National Pipe Tapered) thread connections. The total amount of this purchase is \$116,988 single six-inch Gorman Rupp trash pump to support citywide stormwater operations. This pump will replace Asset 24656, the Thompson Pump model 4DDH-811, which is beyond economic repair and has been decommissioned. These pumps are critical to maintaining reliable maintenance services across the City.

Other brands of portable diesel pumps are available on the market; however, Stormwater has two (2) and Water Reclamation Collections currently has twenty-three (23) Gorman-Rupp portable diesel pumps used for lift station emergencies and maintenance. Maintaining the same brand of equipment has proven to be cost-effective by keeping a smaller spare parts inventory and providing standard operating procedures to all. Stormwater and Utilities Water Reclamation have been pleased with the capabilities and reliability of the Gorman-Rupp pumps for over 20 years and depend on them during maintenance and emergency situations.

This Gorman-Rupp pumps will be used for emergency transfer of water, collecting and/or conveying Stormwater, including, but not limited to, any roads with drainage systems; highways, streets, curbs, gutters, inlets, catch basins, piped storm drains, pumping facilities, structural stormwater controls, ditches, swales, natural and man-made or altered drainage channels, reservoirs and other drainage structures, or any other unforeseen emergencies.

RECOMMENDATION

Given the essential nature of this equipment to our operations and its compatibility with the existing fleet, we request approval to proceed with this single-source purchase from Hudson Pump & Equipment Associates, Inc., using Resolution 131-25.

Such a correction of nonconformities shall be Buyer's exclusive remedy with respect to the Services delivered or performed by Tencarva. Tencarva's liability on any claim shall in no case exceed the purchase price allocable to the Services which gives rise to the claim.

2. To the extent assignable, Tencarva shall assign to Buyer, without recourse to Tencarva, all warranties of the manufacturer of the Products made with respect to the Products. Tencarva makes NO IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF ANY TYPE, WHETHER OF MERCHANTABILITY, OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE with respect to the Products or Services, and no warranties or guaranties, express or implied, are made by Tencarva except as specifically provided herein.

3. IN NO EVENT SHALL TENCARVA BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR SPECIAL DAMAGES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, LOST PROFITS AND ATTORNEY'S FEES, WITH RESPECT TO THE PRODUCTS OR SERVICES OR OTHERWISE. Tencarva shall have no liability with respect to any installation adjustments, repairs or other work done upon or in connection with the Products by Buyer or others. 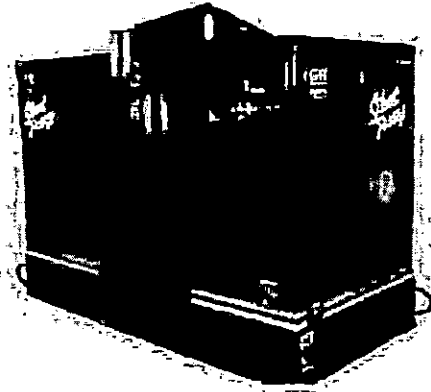

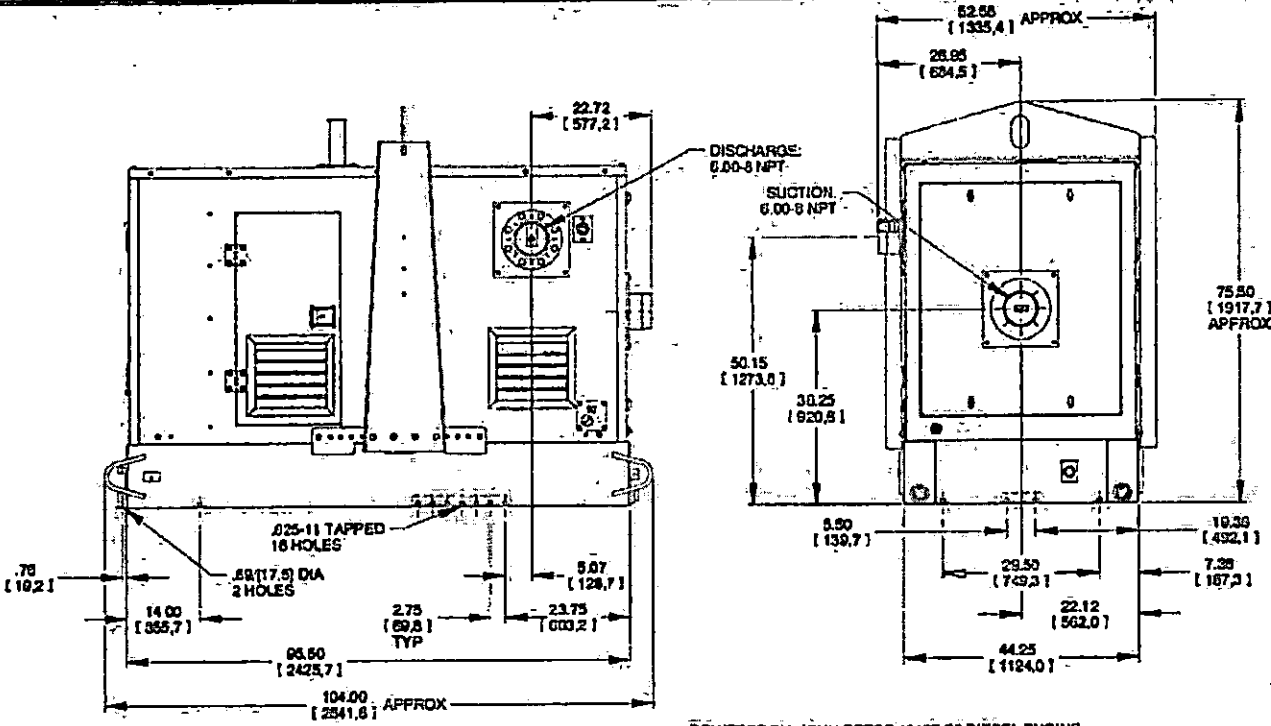

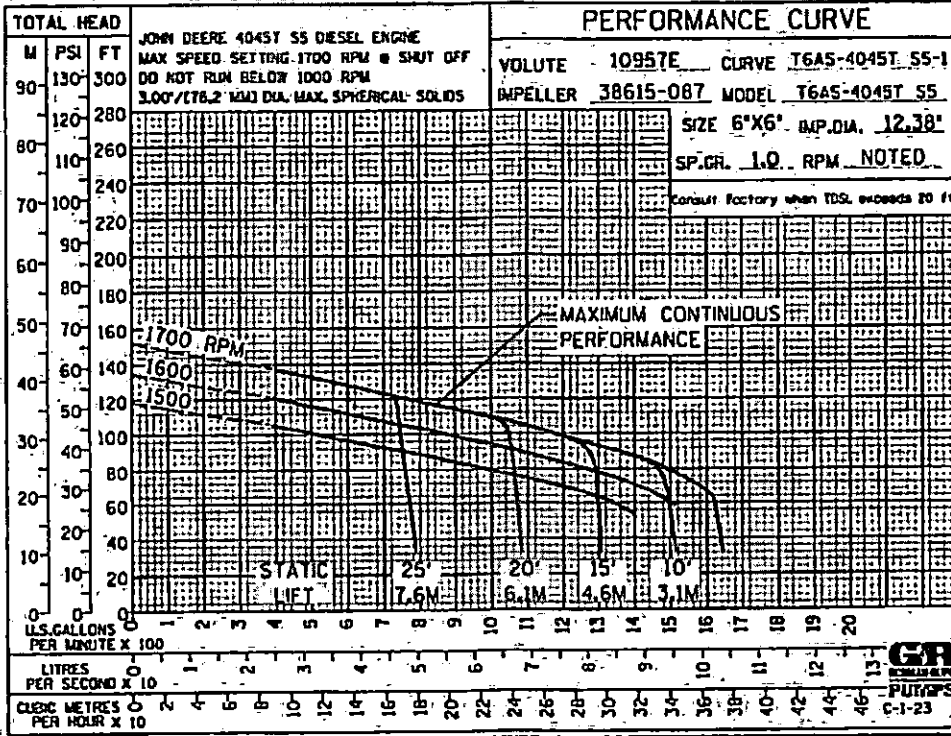

RESOLUTION 131 - 25

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAPE CORAL, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION 314-24, TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF ADDITIONAL VEHICLES AND PERIPHERAL UPFITTING EQUIPMENT IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$2,794,750; APPROVING THE DISPOSAL OF ANY CITY-OWNED SURPLUS TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council adopted Resolution 314-24 on October 30, 2024, which approved the purchase of the budgeted FY2025 capital equipment, vehicles and corresponding peripheral equipment, and hardware and software; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City of Cape Coral, Florida, Code of Ordinances Chapter 2, Article VII, Division 1, Section 2-142(e), the City Manager has the authority to execute all procurement-related purchase orders, contracts, contract amendments and contract renewals in excess of \$100,000 after City Council approval and in accordance with all applicable requirements of Article VII, Division 1, including but not limited to all applicable procurement procedures identified in Section 2-144 of the City's Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, because the equipment, fleet, hardware, and software identified for procurement cover a wide range of assets, equivalents may be used where applicable, purchases may be reviewed and re-prioritized based on use and resource needs; and

WHEREAS, the City's Code of Ordinances Chapter 2, Article VII, Division 3, Section 2-154 identifies the procedures and requirements for the proper disposition of surplus City-owned tangible personal property; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager requests that the Mayor and City Council approve an amendment to Resolution 314-24 to add the following vehicles and peripheral upfitting equipment:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find that, in order to avoid unnecessary delays due to vehicle and equipment failures and to eliminate redundancy in the administrative process, it is in the best interest of the City to approve at this time the execution by the City Manager or their designee of all procurement-related purchase orders, contracts, contract amendments and contract renewals in excess of \$100,000 for the purchase of any and all of the new and replacement equipment, fleet, hardware, and software identified herein that have not yet been purchased

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAPE CORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Council hereby amend Resolution 314-24 and authorize the execution by the City Manager or their designee of all procurement related purchase orders, contracts, contract amendments and contract renewals in excess of \$100,000 pursuant to City's

Code of Ordinances Chapter 2, Article VII, Division 1, Section 2-142(e) for those additional purchases specified herein. The City Manager and his staff shall, at all times, comply with all applicable procurement procedures identified in Section 2-144 of the City's Code of Ordinances.


Section 2. The Mayor and City Council hereby approve the use of equivalents where applicable, the reprioritization of equipment, vehicles and corresponding peripheral equipment, hardware, and software identified herein based upon review of current needs is authorized.

Section 3. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the City Manager or their designee to purchase equipment, vehicles and corresponding upfitting equipment for additional personnel as identified herein.

Section 4. If, as the result of a purchase of a replacement capital asset identified herein, the City Manager determines that any City-owned tangible personal property is surplus, the City Manager is hereby authorized to dispose of the surplus property as provided in Section 2-154(c) of the City's Code of Ordinances. Pursuant to Section 2-154(c)(6), a periodic report shall be submitted for any items sold at auction.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




