



Electric Emergency Hookup and Panel Replacement

Description

This guideline is used when performing an emergency repair of the electrical panel on a residential property.

To apply, use the “Residential Electric Emergency Hookup and Panel Replacement” application on the CSS portal.

Who Can Apply

Electrical Contractor (EC) or Owner/Builder.

Required Documents – always required

- Scope of Work

Conditional Documents – may be required, subject to the details of the parcel and the scope of work

- Notice of Commencement
- FEMA Packet and/or Elevation Certificate

Owner/Builder Documents

- Owner/Builder Affidavit

Private Provider Documents

- Notice to Building Official of Use of Private Provider

Review

- Floodplain, if applicable

Inspections

- Notice of Commencement, if applicable
- Hook-up/SRV CHG
- Electrical Final
- Debris, if using private provider
- Private Provider Compliance Report, if using private provider
