



## Marine Improvement (Boat lift Only)

### Description

This guideline is used when installing just the boat lift on a residential property.

To apply, use the “Marine Improvement” application on the CSS portal. Select the “Boat/Ski Lift” option for type of work.

### Who Can Apply

General Contractor (CGC), Building Contractor (CBC), Residential Contractor (CRC), Marine Specialty Contractor (SCC), or Owner/Builder.

### Required Documents – always required

- Site Plan
- Dock Layout
- Boat lift Specifications
- DEP Approval, if not on fresh water
- Burrowing Owl Gopher Tortoise Affidavit

### Conditional Documents – may be required, subject to the details of the parcel and the scope of work

- Notice of Commencement
- Eagle Management Affidavit
- Hold Harmless Agreement - Used Boat Lift
- Architectural Structural Plans

### Owner/Builder Documents

- Owner/Builder Affidavit

### Review

- Zoning
- Environmental, if applicable

### Inspections

- Notice of Commencement, if applicable
- Marine Final



## Additional Notes

Pilings can be included on this permit.

A separate electrical permit is required for wiring the boat lift. See the "Electric for Dock" guideline.

Private Provider cannot be used with this permit type.
