



**In case you missed it, the following are highlights from the April 1, 2026, Cape Coral City Council meeting.**

**Council Approves Contract for Parks Renovations**

Council approved Resolution 65-26, approving a contract with Sabal Construction and Roofing, LLC for renovations at Jim Jeffers Park and Pelican Soccer Complex for a total amount of \$143,550 to enhance functionality, safety, ADA compliance, and appearance at the parks.

**Council Approves Contract for Roadway Preservation**

Council approved Resolution 78-26, approving a contract with Pavement Technology, Inc. for roadway pavement preservation services, for an estimated annual amount of \$1,801,952, to extend roadway life, improve surface conditions, and maximize maintenance funding efficiency through a cooperative agreement with the City of Punta Gorda.

**Council Approves Contract for Cape Coral Parkway Six-Lane Project**

Council approved Resolution 79-26, approving a contract with Ajax Paving Industries of Florida, LLC for the Cape Coral Parkway East Six-Lane Improvement Project at a total cost of \$2,372,261.29. This project will convert Cape Coral Parkway East, between Triton Court East and a point west of Cape Coral Street, into 6 through lanes, as well as upgrade and retune signals from Chiquita Boulevard through to Del Prado Boulevard.

**Council Approves Contract For Dog Park Drainage Improvement Project**

Council approved Resolution 83-26, approving a staffing and cost proposal with AIM Engineering & Surveying, Inc. for \$136,286.83 to design drainage improvements at the Rotary Park dog park, helping meet environmental permit requirements tied to the Chiquita Lock removal and improving local water quality.
